Psychological problems of orphans:

Inadequate self-esteem. The cognitive dissonance. Anxiety, fears. Mistrust in a relationship. Emotional disturbances. Feeling lonely. Violation of social roles. Adaptation problems, deviance. Early sexual and pathological impulses Impaired communication with adults.



Solution:

The state should show more interest in orphans, give more opportunities after leaving boarding schools. Children should not go after the boarding school and ask for help from passers-by, not have their own home. Send children and teenagers to various educational and cultural programs in order to distract them from socially dangerous phenomena such as drug addiction, alcoholism, bullying!

Orphanhood is a social concept that reflects the situation of orphans. An orphan is a child who is temporarily or permanently either deprived of his family environment, or cannot remain in such an environment and has the right to special protection and assistance provided by the state.
