

INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ERADICATION OF POVERTY

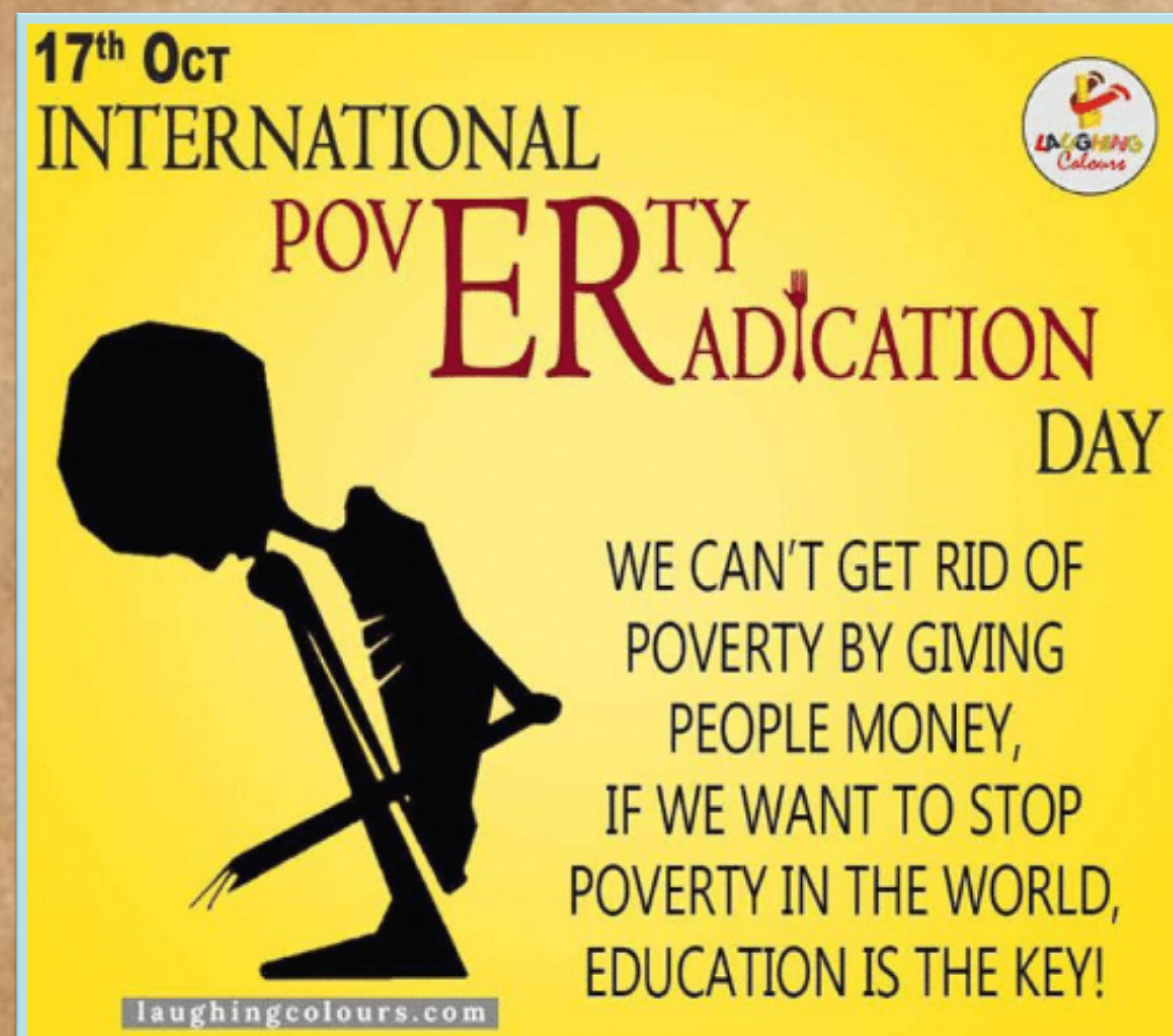
17 OCTOBER
