The programme will educate upcoming innovators in the area of entrepreneurship and business creation through an intensive, tailor-made curriculum. Participants will have the unique opportunity to explore KEY international innovation ECOSYSTEMS (Lausanne, Switzerland and Silicon Valley, USA) and network with major actors from the food & agtech space, top technology experts, startUp mentors, corporates and VCs that will support them fuel innovation across food & agriculture.

The AIM of the programme is to validate early-phase business ideas of PhD students in the Agri-Food sector. The focus will be on how to bring ideas to the market considering food systems sustainability and social impact.

25 highly-motivated PhD students from across Europe will get together for a life-changing, immersive entrepreneurial experience. They will take part into interactive workshops on advanced entrepreneurship, corporate visits, one-to-one business idea feedback sessions and a pitch competition to determine the 15 best ideas to fly to Silicon Valley!

The programme targets PhD students with early-stage Business Ideas from the food & agtech space.
